1. OPENING & ROLL CALL

The Board met in regular session on Tuesday, April 3, 2018 at 9:00 A.M. in the Emergency/Community Room, Mountrail County Justice Center, Stanley, ND with Commissioners Trudy Ruland, Wayne Olson, Garry Jacobson and Daniel Uran present. Commissioner Arlo Borud was absent. Also present was States Attorney Wade Enget.

Vice-Chairman Ruland called the meeting to order.

2. APPOINTMENTS

9:30 A.M.

Shawna McFarland, Social Service Director met with the Board to discuss the VAPS Vulnerable Adult Protective Services job opening that continues to be open and the vacant office space available.

Moved by Comm. Uran, seconded by Comm. Olson, to approve renting the available office space to Summit for therapy services. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Discussion on the Vulnerable Adult Protective Services position whether the county continues to advertise or give this service back to the State of North Dakota. Due to the college graduations coming within the next month to wait and advertise again for the position.

Laurie Johnson, Jail Administrator met with the Board to discuss jail issues.

Discussion on overtime hours due to training for all employees. The board requested a sheet showing the breakdown when this does occur for overtime hours.

Kenneth Halvorson, Sheriff met with the board to discuss vehicle bids.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Uran, to approve the bids for purchasing four 2018 F150- four door, 4 wheel drive, half ton from Prairie Ford with trades of five half ton pickups totaling \$99,748. Upon roll call, all present votes yes. Motion carried.

Jana Hennessy, Road and Bridge Engineer met with the board to discuss road and bridge issues.

Discussion on Blaisdell Spur 67th Ave NW concerning the motion made on 1-11-2016 Commissioner Minutes as stated as follows: *"Moved by Comm. Boschee, seconded by Comm. Jacobson, to approve the weight limit on the South side only of the Blaisdell Spur at 105,500 year round and unless circumstances change on the South portion of the road with the appropriate signs which will be paid by Fairmount Santrol. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried."* Tom McCoy is questioning why the 7 ton per axle frost law restriction is being placed. Currently the frost law on all paved roads is 7 ton per axle/105,500 lbs max once frost law is lifted it becomes by legal weight/105,500 lbs max. Fairmount is requesting this road stay by legal weight/105,500 lbs max year round.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Olson, to approve the Blaisdell Spur 67th Ave NW South portion be at 105,500 lbs by legal weight max year around even when frost law is in effect. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Olson, to approve the testing be done on the pavement on Blaisdell Spur 67th Ave NW South portion on a regular basis being once a year rotation and paid for by Fairmount Santrol after the frost law is lifted. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Uran, seconded by Comm. Olson, to approve and award CR 1 and 2 from Tagus to Ward County Line to Mayo Construction Co. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Olson, seconded by Comm. Uran, to approve and sign the Construction and Maintenance agreement with NDDOT for the Missile project in slope repairs. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried. Discussion on the Old Highway 2 annexation to the City of Stanley which is a small strip.

Moved by Comm. Olson, seconded by Comm. Uran, to go forward with the strip of land on Old Highway 2 to be annexed into the City of Stanley. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Discussion was held on quotes for the 2018 Wetland Monitoring for CR 3 and 12.

Discussion on overtime due to water and road issues along with overweight permits. Board requested and discussed the breakdown sheet when the overtime hours occur.

Discussion on Manitou Township is requesting on adding road mileage to the maintenance agreement.

Moved by Comm. Olson, seconded by Comm. Uran, to approve the extra 1 mile for Manitou Township road maintenance agreement. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Discussion on White Earth Bay Park road problems with neighbors told Engineer Hennessy to discuss with the Association of White Earth Bay if problems keep arising.
