Proceedings of the Mountrail County Commissioners

June 21, 2016

The Board met in regular session on Tuesday at 9:00 A.M. with Commissioners Arlo Borud, Greg Boschee, Garry Jacobson, Colleen Reese, and Trudy Ruland. Also present was Rory D. Nelson with Governor Dalrymple's Office.

Chairman Borud called the meeting to order.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Boschee to approve the Minutes of the June 7, 2016 meeting as corrected. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Boschee, seconded by Comm. Reese, to approve the bills totaling \$2,804,189.46. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried. (A complete list of bills is posted on a regular basis on the Mountrail County Website @ www.co.mountrail.nd.us under the County Commissioner's heading.)

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Reese, to approve the May 2016 fees for the Sheriff's Department and Clerk of Court's Office. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Reese, to approve the transfer to correct a claim voucher that was submitted by the Road & Bridge Department to the incorrect fund totaling \$12,476.48 from the Road & Bridge Fund to the Farm to Market Fund. Upon roll call, all present voted yes.

Moved by Comm. Reese, seconded by Comm. Jacobson, to approve the transfer to close the account from the Game & Fish Fund to the General totaling \$31.00. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Reese, seconded by Comm. Jacobson, to approve the Stop Payment Agreement and reissue check for Joseph Crider/US Fish & Wildlife in the amount of \$9,550.00. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Boschee, to approve the Temporary Full-Time Agreement for William John Reading Jr. for the Weed Department totaling \$17.00 per hour and to not exceed 50 hours per week from June 15, 2016 to July 26, 2016. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Reese, seconded by Comm. Ruland, to approve the appointment of Kathryn Eagle to the Social Service Board for a 3 year term. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Boschee, to approve the request of the Housing Authority of Mountrail County to waive the penalty and interest on property taxes on parcel number 56-0053600. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Stephanie Pappa, Auditor, informed the Board that the current interest rate the County is earning is not what American Bank Center had proposed. The Board directed Auditor Pappa to instruct Shena Wold, Treasurer, to contact American Bank Center and if the proposed rate is not met the money will be moved.

Auditor Pappa informed the Board about Blue Cross Blue Shield's health insurance proposal. The County currently has Sanford as a health insurance provider through the PERS program. Mountrail County would have to leave the PERS program to change to BCBS.

Moved by Comm. Reese, seconded by Comm. Ruland, to approve staying with the PERS program and to not change the health insurance provider. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Boschee, seconded by Comm. Ruland, to approve the Memorandum of Understanding between Mountrail County and NDSU Extension Service to offer 4-H Youth Development Programming and Other Obligated Programs and to appoint Trudy Ruland as the contact person for Mountrail County. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Reese, seconded by Comm. Boschee, to approve States Attorney Wade Enget to draft a Quit Claim Deed due to prior tax deed action to Vernita Finley for Parcel number 58-0008100. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried. Moved by Comm. Boschee, seconded by Comm. Reese, to award the Jail Administrator position to Laurie Johnson with a salary totaling \$60,000 per year. Upon roll call, all present voted yes except for Comm. Jacobson who voted no. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Ruland, seconded by Comm. Boschee, to approve all exempt appointed officials if wanted, to work over 40 hours per week. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Don Longmuir, Planning & Zoning Administrator, and Lisa Lee, Planning & Zoning Assistant Administrator, were present for the hearings pertaining to the zoning amendment.

Chairman Borud opened the 9:30 A.M. public hearing to receive comments on the zoning amendment request filed by Jacob Estvold to rezone a tract of land known as Outlot 1 in the NE¼NW¼ and NW¼NE¼ of Section 24, Township 152 North, Range 92 West in Osborn Township from agricultural to industrial for the purpose of storing pipe.

Administrator Longmuir presented the information from the May 23, 2016 Planning & Zoning public hearing of the Planning & Zoning Commission recommended approval of the zoning amendment filed by Jacob Estvold.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Boschee, to approve the request of Jacob Estvold, for an amendment to the Mountrail County Zoning Ordinance to rezone a tract of land described as Outlot 1 in the NE¼NW¼ and NW¼NE¼ of Section 24, Township 152 North, Range 92 West (Osborn Township) from agricultural to industrial for the purpose of storing pipe in accordance with regulations set forth in the Mountrail County Ordinance and as recommended by the Mountrail County Planning Commission at their May 23, 2016 meeting. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Lori Hanson, Tax Director met with the Board to discuss tax abatements.

Moved by Comm. Reese, seconded by Comm. Ruland, to approve the removal of the 2016 taxes on property number 45-9003700 due to duplicate assessments. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Ruland, seconded by Comm. Reese, to reconvene from the June 7, 2016 County Board of Tax Equalization Meeting at 9:55 A.M. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Tax Director Hanson presented the appeal from Newalta. Tax Director Hanson stated this appeal was tabled at the June 7, 2016 County Board of Tax Equalization Meeting because the notice of increase was not sent to the land owner. Tax Director Hanson also stated Newalta has yet to accept the increase and a 10% increase is needed.

Moved by Comm. Boschee, seconded by Comm. Jacobson, to approve the 10% increase in value on property number 45-0009510. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Reese, seconded by Comm. Boschee, to send all abstracts into the state for the 2016 year. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

No other business was brought before the County Board of Equalization. Equalization adjourned at 10:05 A.M.

Traci Hysjulien, Clerk of Court, met with the Board to discuss issues with the Clerk of Court's Office.

Clerk of Court, Hysjulien requested 12 weeks off for maternity leave and that the Clerk of Courts office not move into the new building until Clerk of Court Hysjulien returns to work in February.

Clerk of Court Hysjulien informed the Board that the computer equipment for the new court room was not budgeted in the new jail facility. Clerk of Court Hysjulien stated the state denied funding for the computers and it is an additional \$15,000 which is available in the Clerk of Court budget.

John DeGroot, Jesse Baker, Thomas P. Nash, and Adam Bangen all with the New Town Fire Department met with the Board to discuss the new fire station. John DeGroot stated the size of the fire station has been reduced and requested \$200,000 from the County. States Attorney Enget will research if the County can contribute and what authority the money would come from if a contribution was made.

Jana Heberlie, Road & Bridge Engineer, met with the Board to discuss Road & Bridge issues.

States Attorney Enget and Engineer Heberlie gave an update on the Palermo South Project and the possible litigation from Ceres.

Engineer Heberlie gave an update in the 2016 chip seal schedule and Asphalt Technologies Corporation was the lowest bidder. Discussion was held on adding the Van Hook Road to the Chip seal schedule.

Moved by Comm. Boschee, seconded by Comm. Reese, to approve the contract and notice to proceed for Asphalt Surface Technologies Corporation the 2016 chip seal projects and to add Van Hook to the schedule. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Boschee, to approve the contract and notice to proceed for Border States Paving on the Old Hwy 2 project. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Reese, to approve change order #1 for the White Earth Bridge replacement decreasing the project by \$2,525.60. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Reese, seconded by Comm. Boschee, to approve the agreement with Aggregate Construction Inc. to purchase stockpiled aggregate from Wirtz Pit with FEMA reimbursement money. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Reese, seconded by Comm. Boschee, to approve the salary increase for Julian Degenstein totaling \$4,570.00 per month starting July 1, 2016. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

The Board met with Laurie Johnson to award the Jail Administrator position.

Brian Kunz, Konrad Johnson, Tim Clark, Eric Thomsen, Grant Hutton, and Mike Janssen with Adolfson & Peterson and Anthony Enright with Klein McCarthy Architects met with the Board to give an update on the new jail facility.

Moved by Comm. Boschee, seconded by Comm. Reese, to appoint Peter Furuseth as a Special State's Attorney from July 1, 2016 to July 31, 2016 as recommended by State's Attorney Enget. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.
