PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF MOUNTRAIL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

OCTOBER 21, 2014

The Board met in regular session on Tuesday at 9:00 A.M. with Commissioners Arlo Borud, Greg Boschee, Trudy Ruland, Garry Jacobson and Colleen Reese present.

Chairman Borud called the meeting to order.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Boschee, to approve the Minutes of the October 7, 2014 meeting as corrected. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Reese, seconded by Comm. Ruland, to approve payment of bills totaling \$5,684,609.21. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried. (A complete list of bills is posted on a regular basis on the Mountrail County Website @ www.co.mountrail.nd.us under the County Commissioner's heading.)

Moved by Comm. Reese, seconded by Comm. Ruland, to approve the September 2014 fee report of the Clerk of Court and the August/September 2014 fee reports of the Recorders Office. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Sharon Smith, 4H Coordinator, met with the Board to discuss how to resolve the conflicts between the NDSU agency and Jim Hennessy, Agriculture Agent. Coordinator, Smith stated to the Board she feels trapped in the middle. Coordinator, Smith believes if there was more direction and a defined role given from NDSU it would help a lot. The Board asked Coordinator Smith what her job title was and she stated she is a youth development, community development and leadership for the 4H program.

Mike Hanson, from NDSU Extension is working on a defined job description for Coordinator Smith and Jim Hennessy as a volunteer for 4H. The Board discussed with Coordinator Smith that the best way to resolve the issues will be communication and the roles being defined. The Board also discussed having a meeting with Jim Hennessy and Sharon Smith to try and resolve the conflicts if needed.

Donald Longmuir Jr., Planning & Zoning Administrator and Lisa Lee, Assistant Planning & Zoning Administrator, were present for the hearings pertaining to zoning amendments.

Chairman Borud opened the 10:00 A.M. public hearing to receive comment on the zoning amendment request filed by Gene Brown to rezone a 9.08 acre, more or less, tract of land in Manitou Township from commercial to industrial and a 30.92 acre, more or less, tract of land from agricultural to industrial for the purpose of accommodating a storage yard. Gene Brown was present for the hearing.

Administrator Longmuir presented information from the September 22, 2014 public hearing of the Planning and Zoning Commission. The Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval of the zoning amendment filed by Gene Brown.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Boschee, to approve the request of Gene & Patricia Brown for an amendment to the Mountrail County Zoning Ordinance to rezone a 40.00 acre, more or less, tract

of land described as SE¼NW¼ including Outlot 1 of E½SE¼NW¼, Sec. 30, Township 156 North, Range 93 West (Manitou Township) from agricultural, (30.92 acres), and commercial (9.08 acres) to industrial to allow for a storage yard for an Enbridge Pipeline project in accordance with regulations set forth in the Mountrail County Zoning Ordinance and as recommended by the Mountrail County Planning Commission at their September 22, 2014 meeting. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Chairman Borud opened the 10:10 A.M. public hearing to receive comment on the zoning amendment request filed by Beau Hill of EOG Resources, Inc., to rezone an 18.53 acre, more or less, tract of land in Parshall Township from agricultural to industrial for the purpose of constructing a water reservoir. Beau Hill and Cally Wescoat with EOG Resources, Inc. and Henry Reiniets with EOG Midstream were present for the hearing.

Assistant Lee presented the information from the September 22, 2014 public hearing of the Planning and Zoning Commission. The Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval of the zoning amendment filed by Beau Hill.

Moved by Comm. Boschee, seconded by Comm. Ruland, to approve the request of EOG Resources, with concurrence from landowners Steven M. & Jeanette A. Hoff, for an amendment to the Mountrail County Zoning map to rezone a 18.53 acre, more or less, tract of land described as Outlot 3 of the NW¼NW¼ of Section 10, Township 152 North, Range 90 West, (Parshall Township) from agricultural to industrial for the purpose of constructing a water reservoir in accordance with regulations set forth in the Mountrail County Zoning Ordinance and as recommended by the Mountrail County Planning Commission at their September 22, 2014 meeting. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Chairman Borud opened the 10:20 A.M. public hearing to receive comment on the zoning amendment request filed by Beau Hill of EOG Resources, Inc., to rezone 6.79 acre, more or less, tract of land in Parshall Township from agricultural to industrial to accommodate a gas compressor station. Beau Hill and Cally Wescoat with EOG Resources, Inc. and Henry Reiniets with EOG Midstream were present for the hearing.

Assistant Lee presented the information from the September 22, 2014 public hearing of the Planning and Zoning Commission. The Planning and Zoning Commission recommended approval of the zoning amendment filed by Beau Hill.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Reese, to approve the request of EOG Resources, with concurrence from landowners Bartelson Investments LLLP, for an amendment to the Mountrail County Zoning map to rezone a 6.79 acre, more or less, tract of land described as Outlot 2 of the NE¼NE¼ of Section 9, Township 152 North, Range 90 West, (Parshall Township) from agricultural to industrial for the purpose of constructing a gas compressor station in accordance with regulations set forth in the Mountrail County Zoning Ordinance and as recommended by the Mountrail County Planning Commission at their September 22, 2014 meeting. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Administrator Longmuir met with the Board to discuss matters dealing with the Planning and Zoning Department. Terry Mathson on the Planning and Zoning board has attended one meeting since June so Administrator Longmuir stated they have a replacement as soon as the paperwork is finished with Mr. Mathson.

Chairman Borud opened the 10:30 A.M. Hearing on Appraisals of Land taken by the County, October 1, 2014 under Tax Deed Action. Representing New Town City, Eileen Zaun and Daleen Johnson from James Hill Township appeared with no objections to the appraisal prices as set by the Board.

Moved by Comm. Reese and seconded by Ruland to close the appraisal hearing and set the tax deed sale for November 18th, 2014 at 10:00 A.M. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

County Engineer, Jana Heberlie, met with the Board to discuss matters dealing with the County Road & Bridge Department. Administrative Assistant, Mary Trahan was present.

The following were present for the 11:00 A.M. bid letting for the purchase of 3 new 2014 six wheel drive motor graders with snow wing, lift group and v-plow: Brett Pappa with County Road and Bridge Crew Foreman, Monte Dyke with County Road and Bridge Supervisor 1, Matt Miller with Butler Machinery, Kent Jaeger with RDO Equipment, and Pat Galvin with ASC Construction Equipment USA.

Moved by Comm. Boschee, seconded by Comm. Reese, to accept the bid of Butler Machinery for 3 new 2014 140M3 Caterpillar six wheel motor graders for the low bid amount of \$943,500 (\$314,500 per grader/attachments) less \$355,000 for the trade of three used motor graders for a net price of \$588,500. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Monte Dyke, Supervisor was questioned about the condition of (CR#14) Parshall East road which he stated the dust control was discontinued and blading will occur weekly.

Engineer Heberlie was advised from the Board that any future bills from Topcon for the GPS units would not get paid since they haven't been working since June 2014. So the Board requested Engineer Heberlie to invite representation to come to next meeting.

Engineer Heberlie presented a request from Gary Johnson with Spring Coulee Township requesting to waive the fee for snow removal. The Board denied.

Moved by Comm. Boschee, seconded by Comm. Ruland, to approve change order #1 for (CR#7) 93rd Ave NW/91st Ave NW containing a change in asphalt cement for the savings of (\$120,750.00). Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Jacobson, seconded by Comm. Reese, to approve change order #2 for (CR#7) 93rd Ave NW/91st Ave NW containing a french drain system for the amount of \$9,735.10. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Boschee, seconded by Comm. Ruland, to approve change order #2 for (CR#5) 89th Ave NW, Ross North consisting of removing a concrete slab within the right of way for the amount of \$532.00. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Engineer Heberlie, stated to the Board she was contacted by Triton Transport LTD to get permission from the County to haul a heavy weight of 241,700 which consisted of a compressor down 71st St NW due to the State not allowing them to travel down Highway 8. Engineer stated she denied the moving permit and will contact Grant Levi at NDDOT concerning the issue.

Mary Trahan, Administrative Assistant met with the Board to give them updates on the financial reports with the County Road and Bridge.

Moved by Comm. Reese, seconded by Comm. Jacobson, to write off two uncollected 2009 bills totaling \$2,651.00. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Ruland, seconded by Comm. Boschee, to hold check from Apex Engineering Group due to wanting to review the contract with State's Attorney, Wade Enget and Apex Engineer, Dane Miller concerning the overage. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Engineer Heberlie, updated the Board that 16 out of 49 townships have signed the permit agreements with the deadline being October 31, 2014.

Comm. Boschee stated to Engineer Heberlie to look into a sweeper for the front of the skid steer due to gravel on pavement in parking lot at the South Complex.

Comm. Reese was given an update from Engineer Heberlie concerning the approach on Van Hook road that wasn't compliant from Mountrail-Williams Electric. The paperwork was submitted so the approach is no longer an issue.

Tax Director, Lori Hanson, met with the Board to present abatements for action.

Moved by Comm. Boschee, seconded by Comm. Reese, to approve Abatements #1737-#1741 as presented by Tax Director Hanson. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.

Jim Hennessy, Agricultural Agent, met with the Board to discuss how to resolve the conflicts between the NDSU agency and Sharon Smith, 4H Coordinator. It was discussed that until clarifications with job duties are outlined the conflicts will not disappear. The Board is requesting Greg Lardy, Department Head and Professor at NDSU to be present at a future meeting to get clarification on job descriptions.

Karen Babbitt, Building Supervisor along with Woody Seeman and Brad Mann from HA Thompson & Sons met with the Board to discuss the options for the data center cooling system in the South Complex. The pros and cons were discussed with a water cooling system versus a data-air unit. HA Thompson & Sons will send us a quote for the data-air unit.

Wade Enget, State's Attorney met with the Board to discuss stances on initiatives and recommends to the Board not to use any monies, letterhead etc associated with the county.

Melissa Vachal, Recorder met with the Board to present matters pertaining to the County Recorder's Office.
