Location: 160 acre tract of land described as the SW^{$\frac{1}{4}$} of Section 28, Township 156 North, Range 92 West (**Ross Township**).

Purpose: Water for fracking using a flat hose

Present: John Anderson with Bakken Water and Dakota Energy Resources

Discussion: Mr. Anderson stated this is a renewal for the same source with a new ND water permit. They have not received the ND water permit yet and would like this variance to be contingent on getting the ND water permit to Planning & Zoning. Commissioner Borud asked if this was for the same location as last month. Mr. Anderson stated yes. Commissioner Hovda asked if any pumping was going on now. Mr. Anderson stated no. Commissioner Borud made the motion to approve the variance once the ND Water Permit was received by Planning & Zoning.

Outcome: Approved with contingencies.

Motion: Moved by Commissioner Borud, seconded by Commissioner Hovda to approve the zoning request filed by Dakota Energy Resources Corp., with concurrence from Scott & Nancy Meier, landowners, for a variance to pump water from an unnamed slough for fracking on a 160 acre tract of land described as the SW¼ of Section 28, Township 156 North, Range 92 West (**Ross Township**) contingent upon the terms and conditions of the ND State Temporary Water Permit ND2018-19167 valid January 4, 2019 through December 31, 2019, only using flat hose, all landowners being contacted regarding hose placement, and adhering to Mountrail County Road & Bridge temporary ROW Use requirements when applicable as Dakota Energy Resources Corp. has met all criteria as set forth in Article IV, Section V of the Mountrail County Zoning Ordinance and is further contingent on Dakota Energy Resources Corp. complying with all other terms and conditions of the Mountrail County Zoning Ordinance. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.
