# STATIC & LIVESTOCK EXHIBITORS New 4-H Online Project Categories

Project Categories on 4-H Online have been updated! These changes have been made so that Project Categories are universal throughout the County, State, & National 4-H levels.

Each family is **required** to go into your 4-H Online account and add/confirm that they have the appropriate Project Categories selected for project they may participate in throughout the year.

\*\* There is no penalty for selecting a Project Category and not participating within it.

Even if you already signed up on 4-H Online earlier you need to go back and check as some classes changed and may have been deleted. Please check ALL project areas.

These new updates have caused some Project Categories to not roll-over from previous years, like they have in the past. So, it is very important that everyone checks this. Some Project Categories have been broken out into their own category or others grouped together. Creative Arts is a project category that is the most popular and is now broke out into more specific categories.
