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Permit is Subject to the Following Conditions:

MOUNTRAIL COUNTY

- Company / Operator must pay a non-refundable permit fee of \$100.00 per crossing and \$250 per mile (if in Mountrail County Right of Way) to Mountrail County, at time of application.
- Company / Operator agrees to restore all roadway(s), and/or right of way(s) or section line(s) caused by its activities to pre-construction condition or better. Restoration shall include but not limited to grading, seeding, straw, mulching and punching. Seeding shall cover the entire disturbed right of way. Any work or material used must be in compliance with with specifications found on the ND Department of Transportation website: <u>https://www.dot.nd.gov/dotnet/supplspecs/standardspecs.aspx</u>. Drainage ditches shall not be impeded.
- 3. Company / Operator must pay a cash bond fee of \$1,000.00 per mile (if in Mountrail County Right of Way) to Mountrail County, at time of application. Minimum cash bond fee will be \$1,000.00. Said fee is refundable provided Company / Operator reclaims roadway(s), and/or right of way(s) or section line(s) to pre-construction condition or better. Reclamation must be done within thirty days after operations are com plete or at expiration of Permit, whichever is sooner. Reclamation must meet approval of the Mountrail County Engineer. If reclamation is not completed within time frame specified herein, cash bond will be used towards repair of damages to existing roadway(s) and/or roads rights of way caused by Company / Operator activities.
- 4. If company fails to restore roadway(s) and/or right of way(s) or section line(s) to preconstruction condition or better, Company / Operator agrees to pay Mountrail County for all damages to existing roadway(s) and/or road right of way(s) or section line(s) caused by its activities including damages in excess of the cash bond paid by said Company / Operator. Damages must be paid for within 30 days of billing from Road & Bridge Department. The amount of any cash bond paid will be deducted from total billing if damages are in excess of cash bond. Company / Operator will be refunded if cash bond is in excess of damages billed. Refund will be for cash bond less damages.
- 5. Company / Operator must send a 24-hour advance written notice to the Mountrail County Road & Bridge Department prior to commencing with any work to conduct a joint pre-inspection to determine and record the existing condition of roadway(s) and right of way(s) or section line(s). Mountrail County reserves right to have personnel on-site during these operations.
- 6. Company / Operator must send a 24-hour advance written notice to the Mountrail County Road & Bridge Department prior to commencing with reclamation. Mountrail County reserves right to have personnel on-site during reclamation operations. At

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completion of reclamation, an on-site post-inspection will be conducted and documented.

- 7. With approved permit, the Company / Operator, will be given the authority to conduct operations within Mountrail County roads, section line, and/or rights of way **ONLY**. This permit does not authorize Company / Operator to conduct any operations on other property.
- 8. Company / Operator is responsible for any and all claims of damage, personal injury, or bodily injury that might result from their activities in crossing any existing road or section line in Mountrail County. Furthermore, Company / Operator agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Mountrail County for any and all claims of damage, either personal injury or property or any type of claim for damages of any nature whatsoever, whether valid or invalid, that is made against Mountrail County on account of the activities conducted by the company in crossing any existing road or section line.
- 9. Company / Operator must place the pipe/hose a minimum of \_\_\_\_\_\_75 \_\_\_\_feet from the center line of the roadway, or outside existing right-of-way. When Company / Operator crosses an existing road or a section line, the Company / Operator shall be responsible to pay for all costs of moving, relocating, or reconstructing the temporary transmission facility should Mountrail County deem it necessary or advisable, at its sole discretion, to repair or reconstruct existing roads or to build new roads on section lines or off section lines as allowed by North Dakota law. Should the company / operator fail to take necessary steps to relocate or reconstruct its temporary transmission facility, the County may take steps to have the same accomplished, and the company / operator agrees to reimburse the County for all expenses incurred by Mountrail County in moving, relocating or reconstructed, or new roads may be built on the section line or off the section line as allowed by North Dakota law.
- 10. Company / Operator must comply with all terms and conditions stated herein, with particular attention to the minimum engineering standards. Failure to comply with this conditional consent shall cause the consent to be rescinded and company / operator must remove facility from right-of-way immediately or be responsible for the cost incurred by the County in removing the same. The County specifically reserves the right to remove the transmission facility from right-of-way for non-compliance and reimbursement will be made to the County by company / operator for doing the same. In case of a rain/water event the company agrees to deflate their pipe/hose to allow water to pass through affected culverts. Company / Operator understands the County has the right to temporarily suspend the permit if placement of this pipe/hose will endanger public health, safety or welfare thereon. County will not be responsible for any cost incurred by company / operator due to such a type of suspension.

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- 11. Company / Operator will comply with OSHA safety standards.
- 12. Company / Operator shall, before installation, upon removal and restoration, call the Mountrail County Road and Bridge Department for inspection.

# 13. <u>This Permit must be approved by the Mountrail County Engineer in writing prior to any</u> work activity being commenced.

- 14. This agreement is binding on the heirs, assigns, or successors of the Company/Operator.
- 15. Wetland: The applicant shall certify that no wetlands will be impacted by the project. If wetlands are impacted, the applicant shall coordinate with the US Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), North Dakota Regulatory Office to determine if a permit is required or mitigation is needed. Certification of avoidance, a wetland delineation, or a permit (if required) from the USACE shall be attached to the application.

I, the undersigned, being an authorized agent of the company / operator described in the above, do herby agree on behalf of the company / operator that all terms and conditions above will be complied with, and any assignment of this facility described above shall include an assignment of this liability to comply with the terms and conditions as stated herein.
