Stephanie A. Pappa, Auditor along with Javayne Oyloe with Upper Missouri District Health Unit (UMDHU) presented the 2026 preliminary Upper Missouri District Health Unit budget.

9:30 A.M.

Kim Savage, Tax Director met with the board to request closing the office for a half day on September 29th, full days on September 30th to October 1st for attending the Vanguard User Group meeting.

Moved by Comm. Hollekim, seconded by Comm. Rice, to approve closing the Tax Director's office for a half day on September 29th, full days on September 30th & October 1st to attend the Vanguard User Group meeting with the Treasurer's office assisting with calls during the closure. The closure was allowed for this year as the training would be beneficial for the newly hired employees, although the office will remain open if the training is made available through live streaming. Moved by Comm. Olson, seconded by Comm. DeGroot, to approve the out of state travel for two people to Alexandria or St. Cloud, MN on October 8 & 9th and Laurie Johnson to River Falls, WI on September 24 & 25th. Upon roll call, DeGroot, Ruland, Rice, Olson and Hollekim voted yes. Motion carried.

9:45 A.M.

Jana Hennessy, Road & Bridge (R&B) Engineer along with Scott Duerre, Superintendent met to discuss Road & Bridge.

1. CR4 RECONSTRUCTION & POWER POLE RELOCATION

Engineer Hennessy discussed the ongoing conversation for the CR4 Reconstruction and Power Pole Relocation with Mountrail Williams Electric Cooperative (MWEC). Wade Enget, State's Attorney discussed North Dakota Century Code (N.D.C.C.) 24-01-42 prohibiting construction within 75 feet of the centerline of any county highway right of way without first obtaining consent of the board of county commissioners. Chairman Ruland also discussed that on the Williams County side all poles were outside of the 75' right of way but not in Mountrail County. Kyle Sorenson, MWEC landman stated that in Williams County they had all the right of way acquired. Alex Vournas, General Manager of MWEC discussed working together for a cost-effective solution for both parties. MWEC General Manager Vournas also discussed splitting the cost of the east section of CR4 for the moving of the distribution/transmission lines with an estimate totaling \$2,042,400. Craig Mizera, HDR Engineering discussed the possibility of shifting the road to the North. This will be discussed at the next commissioner meeting. Later in the meeting it was verified that the Paulson Creek Bridge 150' right of way was acquired back in 1980.

2. CR11-PROJECT 11(67)23

Engineer Hennessy along with Craig Mizera and Jon Skjordal with HDR Engineering discussed Dale Brown's request for changes to driveway. The cost for Option 3 for the MWEC to lower the underground electrical is \$86,000 not to exceed \$132,500. The contractor costs to cut slopes and reconstruct the approach to preconstruction location would be in addition to MWEC's estimate for underground electrical. Dale Brown was in agreement with this option.

Moved by Comm. DeGroot, seconded by Comm. Rice, to approve moving forward with Dale Brown's approach as Option 3 to have MWEC to lower the underground electrical and the contractor cut the slopes and reconstruct the approach to pre-construction location totaling \$86,000 not to exceed \$132,500 plus the cost of the Contractor. Upon roll call, Ruland, Rice, Olson, DeGroot and Hollekim voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Hollekim, seconded by Comm. DeGroot, to approve the change order #2 for a cultural resource documentation by the State Historical Preservation Office for Project 11(67)23 CR11 reconstruction totaling \$7,700. Upon roll call, Hollekim, Ruland, DeGroot, Rice and Olson voted yes. Motion carried.

3. CR10 EAST - PHASE I & CR 11

Engineer Hennessy discussed moving CR10- East Phase I & CR11 from 2027 to paving in 2026.

Moved by Comm. DeGroot, seconded by Comm. Olson, to approve moving forward with the paving project in the year 2026 for CR10 East Phase I and CR11 consisting of approximately 21.91 miles of CR10/53rd St NW from CR11/67th Ave east approximately 7 miles to Ward County and CR11/67th Ave NW from 53rd St NW north approx. 6 miles to 59th St NW and the Phase II portion of CR10/51st St NW from 74th Ave NW east approx. 7 miles to 67th Ave and 67th Ave NW north approx. 2 miles to CR10/53rd St NW at an estimated cost of \$18,549,757.05 for construction and engineering. Upon roll call, Rice, Hollekim, Olson, DeGroot and Ruland voted yes. Motion carried.

4. CR10 WEST-PHASE II RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Moved by Comm. Olson, seconded by Comm. Rice, to approve the advertising for CR10 West-Phase II Reconstruction Project at an estimated cost \$13,064,345.15 for construction and engineering and include along with paving of CR10 and CR11 as discussed above. Upon roll call, Ruland, Olson, Rice, DeGroot and Hollekim voted yes. Motion carried.

5. CR3 - CHANGE ORDER NO 1
