Scott Duerre, Road & Bridge (R&B) Superintendent along with Mary Trahan, Road & Bridge (R&B) Accountant met to discuss Road & Bridge.

1. BR10625-BRIDGES NO. 31-106-25.0 BID OPENING

R&B Superintendent Duerre discussed the bid tabulations for Bridge Project No. 31-106-25.0 located on 53rd St NW over the White Earth Creek in Section 3, Township 154, Range 94.

Moved by Comm. Olson, seconded by Comm. Rice, to approve the notice of award to Martin Construction Inc. for Bridge Project No. 31-106-25.0 totaling \$1,060,197. Upon roll call, Rice, Ruland, Olson, DeGroot and Hollekim voted yes. Motion carried.

2. CR 9 PHASE II-COTTAGE SITE DESIGN

Craig Mizera, HDR Engineering discussed the White Earth Cottage site design options through Lots 4, 5, and 43-45. Depending on what is done to convey storm water, construction easements may be needed for these properties. If easement cannot be obtained from the landowner(s), the County would have to work within their own right of way and let the water flow where it would naturally flow. Engineer Mizera recommended that any future maintenance be the landowner's responsibility for any pipe, rip-rapping or matting that is used to slow erosion on their property. Engineer Mizera along with R&B will meet with the landowners for recommendations and plans for Lots 4, 5, and 43 through 45.

3. CR 6 – White Earth West to Williams County Line

Moved by Comm. Hollekim, seconded by Comm. Olson, to approve land acquisition for CR 6 as cropland per acre \$2,300; pasture land per acre \$1,000 and temporary per acre \$300. Upon roll call, Rice, Ruland, Hollekim, DeGroot and Olson voted yes. Motion carried.

4. 213 CAPITAL TRANSFERS

Discussion was held on the Capital Construction projects that will be transferred to the 213 Road & Bridge (R&B) Capital Projects Fund for the 2023 year.

Moved by Comm. Olson, seconded by Comm. DeGroot, to approve the transfer from R&B fund to the R&B Capital Projects fund for PM 2022 Chip Seal Projects totaling \$1,557,219.25. Upon roll call, Hollekim, Ruland, Rice, Olson and DeGroot voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Hollekim, seconded by Comm. Rice, to approve the transfer from R&B fund to the R&B Capital Projects fund for Cottonwood Lake Bridge Project B31(056) totaling \$381,470. Upon roll call, DeGroot, Ruland, Olson, Hollekim and Rice voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. Rice, seconded by Comm. Hollekim, to approve the transfer from R&B fund to the R&B Capital Projects fund for CR 6 Project 06(68)22 totaling \$8,848,600. Upon roll call, Rice, Ruland, Olson, Hollekim and DeGroot voted yes. Motion carried.

Moved by Comm. DeGroot, seconded by Comm. Olson, to approve the transfer from R&B fund to the R&B Capital Projects fund for CR 12 Project 12(42)22 totaling \$12,650,000. Upon roll call, Olson, Rice, DeGroot, Hollekim and Ruland voted yes. Motion carried.

4. MISCELLANEOUS

Paul Royer discussed lowering the speed limit due to heavy traffic and safety concerns along CR 9 to 99th Ave NW for about a mile. Corey Bristol, Sheriff stated lowering the speed limit would improve the safety of the residents.

Moved by Comm. Olson, seconded by Comm. Rice, to set the speed limit at 45 mph for cars and 35 mph for trucks on the section of gravel road referred to as Old Highway 2 from the intersection of CR2 and CR 9 east to 98th Ave NW, between Section 15 and 14 in Myrtle Township. Upon roll call, all present voted yes. Motion carried.
