- 1) 2 Gallon min. for each sample
- 2) Uniform size & color
- 3) Minimal weed or other crop seeds
- 4) Variety name
- 5) Make sure your grain is dry enough for storage!

Don't have access to grain? You may ask a neighbor farmer for help! We would gladly accept extra grain that they are willing to donate for other participating youth as well.

What will I learn?

- 1) Why grain cleaning samples are important and how it is used in the industry.
