One Kid will receive a goat kid and supplies to participate in the 2025 Mountrail County 4-H Achievement Days and beyond!





## The Winner shall:

- Take ownership of the goat at the time of pickup.
- Provide adequate facilities to care for the goat, such as shed/barn.
- Feed the goat appropriately and provide adequate water. Feed and bedding costs are the responsibility of the 4-Her.
- Care for the goat in such areas as health and parasite control. Any vet bills will be the responsibility of the 4-Her.
- Keep records showing proper management and feeding.
- Follow all the rules necessary to participate in the Mountrail County Achievement Days.
- Exhibit the goat at the July 9, 2025 Mountrail County Achievement Days.
- Market or keep the goat at the conclusion of the show season (profits retained by the winner).



## KIDS FOR KIDS

Mountrail County 4-H and Big Bend Nubians of New Town, ND announce the **Kids for Kids** for 4-H members in the county who are actively involved in or would like to be involved in a 4-H Goat Project. One winning entrant will receive a registered Nubian dairy goat kid which will be eligible for the 2025 Achievement Days and some supplies to help get started.



Contestants will submit a personally written, one page, one side ONLY typed essay on what ownership of a goat would mean to them, including how they would provide care, the environment in which the goat would be raised, and any other pertinent and/or human interest information they wish to share, along with the completed Entry Form and Consent to Entry and Release of Liability. Do not include the name or any identification of the contestant on the essay itself. The completed Entry Form, Consent to Entry and Release of Liability form, and essay on Essay Form must be submitted to the Mountrail County Extension Office by April 1st, 2025. Incomplete submissions will not be reviewed and will be discarded without consideration. The one winning entry will be selected by the Mountrail County 4-H Council at its sole discretion, based on the Council's evaluation of the merits of the entries. The entrant's chances of winning are based on the number of entrants and the skill and proficiency of the entries. All entries become the property of the Mountrail County Extension Office, and will not be returned.

Current or new 4-Hers are encouraged to apply for this opportunity! Applications are due **April 1st, 2025 at midnight** to the Extension Office with the winner announced by April 20th. Pick up will be on scheduled at the United Quality Coop New Town Ag Retail Center.

Essay Ideas...Consider including the following information in your essay: Why do you want to win-agoat? What do you think you will learn while participating in the goat project? Describe the facilities you will use to care for the goat. What financial arrangements will you make for the project? Will the project be fed alone or with other goats? How many years, including this one, have you participated in a 4-H livestock project? Which species?
