



# Required ND State Fair Livestock Trainings



**\* Not currently required for county Achievement Days \***

All exhibitors showing livestock at the ND State Fair **MUST** participate in either an LQA or YQCA training prior to participating in any ND State Fair 4-H Show.

Those exhibiting swine, beef cattle, dairy cattle, sheep, goats, rabbits, & poultry must complete this training.

Livestock Quality Assurance & YQCA trainings help youth provide excellent care for their food animals and ensure a high level of food safety to consumers. It is designed to enhance the educational experience of 4-H animal science projects.

**There are TWO options available to meet this requirement.**

### Online Training – Valid for 1 Year

Go to <http://yqcaprogram.org> (Firefox and Chrome browsers work best)

1. Click on Login & Register (top right corner).
2. Register for a new account if you have not established one yet or Log in with your previous account.
3. Once logged in, select “add a child” if you are the guardian creating the account. Otherwise, select “purchase a course” if you are the youth who is logged in. Find the course that is within your current age.
4. Select Web-Based Training (\$12) OR Select Instructor-led training (\$3), then North Dakota, and then select the scheduled training that is closest to your location. Trainings are continuously being added, so if you don’t see one, check back later or call your Extension office.
5. Once completed with either course, print your YQCA certificate and provide a copy to your Extension agent. Keep this on file for this current year.
