1. OPENING & ROLL CALL

The Board met in special session on Monday, March 7, 2022 at 8:00 A.M. with GOTOMEETING with Commissioners Trudy Ruland, Wayne Olson, Daniel Uran and Jason Rice all present via GOTOMEETING and Commissioner Joan Hollekim was present at Courthouse. Wade Enget, State's Attorney was present.

Lori Hanson, Tax Director stated there are a lot of holes from nails in the woodwork that need to be filled. Building Supervisor Ellis stated that the north door will be supplied by Modern Woodworks. Pat Dittbrenner stated that this was a basic remodel when they started and became to be more time consuming due to the upgrades requested.

Olson, to approve paying Dittbrenner Woodworking LLC for the remainder of the work completed totaling \$19,733.45 pending receipt of the signed lien releases for material suppliers and subcontractors and the checklist being completed. Upon roll call, Hollekim, Ruland, Uran, Olson and Rice voted yes. Motion carried.
